This weekend is Sea Sunday, a time to remember all those who work at sea, and in our ports. So much of what we eat, what we wear and what we use for buildings comes from abroad, and the vast majority comes by sea. Covid-19 has had a particularly serious effect on those working at sea; with shore leave restricted or non-existent, the ship's crew are often confined to the ship for months on end.

In our Diocese, we have very busy ports at Harwich and Tilbury, and they are served by Chaplains supported by the Apostleship of the Sea. Many of those who work on ships are Catholic, and the provision of Chaplaincy, including Mass and other Sacraments, is a really crucial service, helping the spiritual and mental well-being of the crew members.

The link will be the same every week, and Masses can be viewed from any tablet, smartphone, or laptop, anywhere in the world. Masses will also be recorded, so that they can be prayed later in the day, if that is helpful. We believe this is an essential support for housebound, shielding and vulnerable parishioners, as well as for those with difficult weekend shifts, and we welcome any feedback about this.

For the Sunday 9.30 Mass and special occasions we are particularly grateful to parish volunteers, who will enable the link to be "curated" with different camera angles, etc. For other Masses there will be a single shot of the altar and lectern.

"Lourdes at Your Local"

From **Monday 26th - Friday 30th July** (the usual week of the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes), Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Alan each morning at 11am, with Anointing of the Sick and joyful music, followed by a cup of coffee and refreshments in the parish hall afterwards. The Masses will take place in Leigh-on-Sea, Clacton-on-Sea, Canning Town, Wanstead and Brentwood and everyone is warmly invited. Our nearest Mass is at **Brentwood Cathedral** at 11am on **Friday 30**th **July.**

These will then be streamed online each evening, and there will also be a Daily Rosary & Torchlight Procession available to take part in virtually during the week.
