This weekend we will hear a Pastoral Letter from Bishop Alan, considering our Catholic response to the urgent and serious issues caused by climate change. Pope Francis exhorts us to "Listen and respond to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor." For some months in the parish we have begun this work; now we are part of an approach from across the whole Diocese. Bishop Alan says, "We are not speaking just as another pressure group or campaign group – though both pressure and campaigns are needed. We enter this conversation because it is integral to our faith that we cherish God's creation, and strive for justice for the world's poorest people."

Today we are given an invitation to make three personal pledges – actions to help reduce our impact on the environment, to pray, and to serve the poor. What will you do? At the same time the Diocese – which already pays the Real Living Wage, sources energy from renewables, and has a strong ethical investment policy, is **divesting from fossil fuels**, and **taking professional advice to seriously reduce our carbon footprint**.
