Parish Finance Update - 2022/23

These are the day to day figures – the Building Project figures are recorded separately, and the headline details are on the third page.

The very good news is that in the day to day running of the parish from April 2022 – April 2023 there is a surplus of £16,249

This is in the context of significant inflation, as well as **cost of living pressures** for many people.

It has been achieved by many families and individuals making regular donations,

plus very careful control of parish expenditure. More details over the page.

Day to Day Parish Income and Expenditure – Headline Figures

The best way to give to the parish is by Standing Order, plus (if you are a taxpayer) Gift Aid. This is regular, cashless, and does not attract bank charges. There is a sheet with how to set up a Standing Order at the back of the church, which includes Gift Aid information.

There are numerous other items of expenditure, including small maintenance and repairs bills, everything we spend on liturgies and Masses (hosts, wine, booklets). There is always another bill to pay – <u>again thank you for all that you give</u>.

All these figures tell just one part of the story. There are also many, many voluntary hours given, huge amounts donated to charity, and time spent in care, kindness, prayer and service. All of it is priceless, and precious. For it all, thank you.

Total income related to the building project in 22/23 £1,070,611

So the pledged parish fundraising is approx. £120,000. We are aiming for £500,000 and so we hope more people will take out standing orders, or make one off donations, as the project continues. There are forms to be able to do this at the back of the church – or use the website information on the back page. And if you are a taxpayer – **Gift Aid it!**

Albert Gubay Foundation Grant notified to us in March 2022, and paid in the new financial year, but worthy of note here: £200,000

Other grants have been applied for, hoping for a further £150,000 in grant funding.

We can reclaim VAT on the works to the church, as it is a listed building = £80,000 reclaim

Once the hall is operational, we would expect it to generate income; if needed, this will help pay the final part of the project costs.

Total expenditure relating to the building project in 2022-23 £271,600

(+ expenditure from 2020 - 2022 = £97,000 (incl £14,000 to adapt the parish hall so we could use it during the last two years). So the total spend so far is £368,600

Planned total expenditure will be £2,090,000, by the conclusion of the project, with final bills due by early 2024. So the fundraising remains vital! If you have not already made a contribution, please take out a standing order, or make a donation, if you can. Raising £500,000 = 500 families/individuals giving £1,000. This is a lot – but it is £5/week (the price of a coffee and a cake at Costa!) for four years. Please – give this, if you can. Thank you.

^{*}Many of the parish donations and standing orders are Gift Aided. Also over half the donations are from the beginnings of Standing Orders set to run until 2026.
