<u>The lockdown ends at 12.01am (just after midnight) on the morning of Wednesday 2nd December.</u> Collective worship is again permitted and so our normal Mass schedule resumes with Mass at 12.15pm Wednesday, 2nd December, and weekend Masses from next weekend 5th /6th December at 6.30pm Saturday, 9.30am and 11.30am Sunday. Numbers remain limited, and all the Covid restrictions are in place – face coverings, track and trace, sanitiser and no group singing! But we can gather again, and we look forward to welcoming you back, if it is safe for you to attend.

The 9.30am Mass will continue to be Livestreamed, via the parish YouTube channel. The direct link is posted on the website each week.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent; as we consider the precarious and unusual journey of the Holy Family, we know that this year their journey resonates deeply in our lives, and across the world. In a particular way we pray for pregnant mothers, and for all who are undertaking difficult journeys in the next few weeks.
