We continue to pray for all those affected by Covid-19. It has been a week of quite high case numbers in Havering, but thankfully (due to vaccinations and the booster) the effects for most people do generally seem mild. For those who are seriously ill, and for the nurses, doctors, hospital support staff, teachers, key workers and front line workers, we know there are still a lot of pressures, and we hold you all in prayer.

This weekend (22nd/23rd January) is the third (and final) weekend focusing on the Synod questions – the Church listening across the world. The answers from the first two weeks have been really insightful. We'll be sharing the summaries with everyone in the next few weeks, with an open meeting later in the spring.

The focus for this weekend is **Mission and dreams:** How well do we reach into the town we serve? How do we reach those on the edges, the margins? What else could we do? What is your dream for the future of the Church?

This focus on mission is deeply rooted in this weekend's Gospel – Jesus' first proclamation of his mission: to bring the good news to the poor, liberty to captives and sight to the blind. Have a look at Luke chapter 4, to see what Jesus says – and how the crowd react!
