Save the date - the opening and blessing of the narthex and parish centre will be celebrated with Bishop Alan on Friday 31st May, 7pm.

<u>Help needed at each Mass.</u> Please can you consider becoming one of our Stewards at weekend Masses? The role of the Steward is:

- To be a warm and welcoming face at the church doors
- To assist when people move around the church for Holy Communion
- To ensure emergency exits are clear, and to help in any emergency situation; this includes any emergency which involves evacuating the church
- To help at the end of Mass, including tidying the church and closing windows.

We need three Stewards at each Mass, so ideally 12 stewards from each congregation, so everyone is on the rota once a month. To help, you need to be:

- Age 18+
- Warm and welcoming
- Fully mobile, so as to assist others if needed

There is a sign up sheet at the back of the church. There will be a training evening for existing and new Stewards from 6.30 – 8pm on 23rd May. This will specifically include fire safety training. It is vital for us to have Stewards, especially with our large congregations – please do step forward for this.
