The good news is that the day to day running of the parish from April 2023 – March 2024 showed a surplus of £8,541

We have also raised £1.77million towards the building project. This is amazing – but it still leaves a shortfall of approx. £300,000. With this sheet are all the ways to give!

All of this is in the context of significant cost of living pressures for many people. It has been achieved by many families and individuals making regular donations, plus very careful control of parish expenditure.
