**First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation Preparation is open for children who will be in Year 3 or above in September.** The application forms are available at the back of the church and must be returned by **Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2024**. The parents' evening will be **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October,** and the celebration of Communion will be in May 2025.

**Confirmation** will be slightly different this year – open to anyone **currently in Year 10 or Year 11** (or sixth form), with sessions beginning in December, and concluding with Bishop Alan's visit on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Full details will be available in the next two weeks, with applications open until the end of October.

We are in the midst of The Season of Creation, which runs from September 1<sup>st</sup> to the Feast of St Francis of Assisi, Patron Saint of the Poor and the Environment, on October 4<sup>th</sup>. Autumn is a wonderful time to notice nature – as the leaves change colour, there is particular beauty to be discovered. On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September at 1.30pm everyone is warmly invited to meet at the gates of Raphael Park and join the Parish Laudato Si' group on a reflective and prayerful walk.
