But to get us started we will have a tiny tree throughout Advent, and encourage gifts of toys, chocolate and toiletries. This will mean we can get them to families who we know are in need, including via S.M.I.L.E. and to those at the women's refuge, so they have them before Christmas Day.

Items given on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day are still very welcome, of course, and these will be given where they are most needed in the New Year.

Please do not wrap gifts but simply leave them unwrapped, or in gift bags.

There remains an ongoing need for Foodbank Donations, Donations can be left in bags in the side chapel any time the church is open.

Home visits. Each Advent and Lent – and at any other time when there is emergency need – Fr Dominic visits housebound parishioners in their homes, or care homes within the parish. If you, or a friend or relative, would like a visit, please speak with Fr Dominic or contact Julia in the parish office. All through the year Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist can visit with Holy Communion. Visits can also be arranged from the SVP or Legion of Mary – just let us know, so that no-one is alone.

**Can you help?** Each weekend after 6.30pm and 11.30am Masses Fr Dominic locks all the buildings, sets the hall alarm, etc. The stewards and sacristans do a great job but it really would be a help to have a couple of people who could do the final "site lock up" on a Saturday evening and a Sunday lunchtime.
