### **Secondary School Admissions – Certificate of Catholic Practice**

For those with children in Year 6 applying to Catholic Secondary Schools for admission in September 2026 your application should be supported by a Certificate of Catholic Practice. This is only needed for The Campion School and Sacred Heart of Mary Girls' School and indicates that you attend Mass regularly; if that applies to you, please bring your child's Baptism Certificate and Fr Dominic will have copies of the Certificate to sign for you after any of the weekend Masses on 18<sup>th</sup> /19<sup>th</sup> October. No appointment is needed. Applications to the Brentwood Ursuline do not need a certificate, and nor do Catholic primary school applications in Havering.

Are you an adult who would like to become a Catholic? Perhaps you have never been Baptised, or Baptised but never received Holy Communion or Confirmation? There is a wonderful Journey in Faith (RCIA) group for adults starting in October, with the chance for excellent conversation, asking questions, and – if you wish – preparing for Sacraments, celebrated at Easter 2025.
